

One day workshop for HFAT trained investigators who are looking to further develop & hone their HFAT skills & knowledge.

This 1 day workshop will involve analysing the human factors aspects of a confined entry incident. Delegates will be required to identify & define key behaviours, develop question sets, interview key witnesses (played by actors) and analyse key behaviours using the HFAT tool. Each stage of the process will be followed by a period of reflection & discussion on lessons learned.
